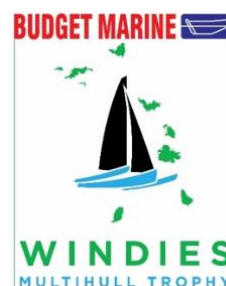

NOTICE OF 2027 SERIES

CONCEPT

A season championship for offshore multihulls racing throughout the Caribbean. The aim is to encourage offshore multihulls to enter Caribbean regattas.

ORGANISING AUTHORITY

The organising authority is the Caribbean Sailing Association.

COORDINATING COMMITTEE

ELIGIBILITY

All multihulls which have made the passages between the events under their own steam (sail or power).

DIVISIONS

Two divisions are recognised: Multihulls with the LOA of less than 60' and those with a LOA of 60' and above.

HANDICAP SYSTEM

Boats will be scored using the CSA Multihull Rating. Boats must have a current 2027 Digitally Certified CSA Multihull Rating Certificate which may be applied for at Caribbean-Sailing.com

TROPHY

A bespoke perpetual trophy which will have each season's winners engraved on it. Small replica trophies will be presented to the first place for each division.

SCORING

A boat counts her best 5 scores (CSA scores only) from the following passage race and regatta events from 3 regions:

- A yacht must sail an event in at least two regions to qualify for the Windies Multihull Trophy.
- If a yacht sails events in all three regions a bonus point is awarded.
- Scoring is calculated using the number of entrants in the yacht's class in each event. First Place scores the number of boats in the class. Second Place Number in boat minus 1 and so forth. Last Place scores 1 point
- First place in a class in an event will receive a bonus point.
- The boat with the highest total score is declared the winner of the WMT. Should two or more yachts receive the same total scores for their best five events, the tie shall be broken by the yacht which has sailed in the most eligible events shall be the winner.
